Urgent Safeguarding Update

In recent weeks/ days there has been lots of talk in schools about Omegle. Omegle has been around for a number of years, but is gaining popularity again as there's a trend on TikTok where users screen recording their Omegle chats.

What is Omegle?

- Omegle is a website that requires no sign-up
- Users turn their webcams on, and then randomly connect with strangers around the world who are on the site
- Users then video chat or text chat
- There is very little monitoring of the site
- A phone app is also available
- The site even advertises itself as a place to 'meet strangers'

What Are the Risks?

This is self-explanatory, and the site is open to mis-use due to the 'random' nature and lack of monitoring/ reporting tools.

What Should I Do at Home?

Just be aware and vigilant. We always recommend to check your child's phone regularly and monitor their use. If you are concerned or would like any help or more advice, please just come and speak to us!
